## 2. SCOPE


2.1. This policy applies to all Surrey Police Service (SPS) Members.


## 3. POLICY

# **APPENDIX A: DEFINITIONS**

"FLIST" means the Frontline Investigative Support Team.

"GO" means General Occurrence report written in the PRIME-BC records management system.

"Member" means a sworn Police Officer appointed by the Surrey Police Board.

"Primary Investigator" means the Member assigned to conduct the investigation and complete the General Occurrence report.

"SPS" means Surrey Police Service.

"Supervisor" means a Sergeant, Staff Sergeant, Inspector, Superintendent, Deputy Chief Constable, Chief Constable, and any other person acting in a Supervisory capacity who is accountable for a particular area or shift on behalf of SPS.
