Report Notes & Data Qualifiers

The crime and offence data in this report is drawn from the PRIME records management system which captures occurrences that were either reported to or discovered by police. Unless otherwise specified, counts represent the total number of police files, not the total number victims or items stolen. The data includes all crime types (i.e., not just the most serious) with a primary investigative unit of Surrey Police Service (SPS) or Surrey RCMP/Surrey Provincial Operations Support Unit (SPOSU). Date information in this report reflects the date the incident was reported. File counts are provided by the Surrey police district in which the incident occurred, not the district in which an incident was reported. The totals for each incident type include files for which the occurrence location and district were unknown.

On 2024-11-29, SPS became the police of jurisdiction for the City of Surrey; from this date, Surrey policing statistics combine data from the SPS and the Surrey RCMP/SPOSU. Data should be interpreted with caution due to different organizational policies and data protocols between agencies. As PRIME is a “real-time” database, the information in this report is preliminary incident data and may not represent statistics submitted to the Canadian Center for Justice Statistics; the data is subject to change for a variety of reasons, including late reporting, the stage of an investigation, reclassification due to changes in circumstances, and policing transition related factors such as the transfer of legacy incidents from Surrey RCMP/SPOSU to SPS.

Category	Details
Homicide	The number of homicide-related deaths, not the number of police files. Counts are the product of SPS file review and reconciliation with IHIT data.
Shots Fired	Defined as a confirmed, deliberate discharge of a firearm, excluding police involved incidents, accidental firearm discharge, hunting/recreational firearm use in permissible areas, and suicide. Files are identified via a crime analyst review of Surrey PRIME files.
South Asian Extortion Series	Files are identified via a crime analyst review of Surrey PRIME files.
MV Fatalities	The number of motor vehicle-related deaths, not the number of police files. Counts are provided by SPS Collision Investigation Unit.
Mental Health Related Files	Includes files with PRIME Special Study Flag code “B” (“Mental Health Related”); all CCJS codes except “A” (“Unfounded”).
Total Calls for Service	The total number of Surrey PRIME Calls for Service, excluding files coded as “duplicate” or “cancelled”.
